STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the George Green Estate.

George Green Estate; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$10,000 to be paid to the George Green Estate, located at South Thomaston as full and final settlement against the State for damage to property caused by the building of a bridge at Wessaweskeag river, South Thomaston, by the State Highway Commission; said sum to be paid from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In the building of a bridge by the State Highway Commission, a dam was destroyed without authority of law, to the damage of the George Green Estate.
