STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Apportionment of School Funds on Basis of Pupil Enrollment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 238-A, additional. Chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 238-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 238-A. Apportionment on basis of pupil enrollment. In addition to the educational aid provided by section 238, the Commissioner of Education shall apportion to each city, town, plantation and community school district of the State the amount of \$15 for each pupil enrolled in the public schools on April 1st, annually, in each such city, town, plantation and community school district.'
