STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Members of the Maine-New Hampshire Interstate Bridge Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1937, c. 18, § 4, amended. The last 3 sentences of section 4 of chapter 18 of the private and special laws of 1937, as enacted by chapter 147 of the private and special laws of 1947, are hereby amended to read as follows:

'Said members of said Authority for this State, other than the Chairman of the State Highway Commission, shall be paid, for such time as they are actually engaged in the work of the Authority, such sum per day as the Governor and Council may determine, provided such sum shall not exceed \$8 a day each. All members shall be allowed their actual expenses. \$20 for each day in attendance at an official meeting and be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his duties. The compensation and expenses provided for herein shall be a charge upon the funds of the Authority.'
