AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Muskrats in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 113, sub-§ I, amended. The 4th paragraph of subsection I of section 113 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The open season on mink and muskrat shall be during the month of November in each calendar year; except that the open season on muskrat in Washington and York counties, and in the towns of Porter, Hiram, Denmark, Brownfield, Fryeburg, Stow, Lovell, Sweden and Stoneham in the county of Oxford, composing the area embraced by the Oxford Western District Registry of Deeds, shall be only from March 20th to April 20th, inclusive, in each year.'
