## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Place Operating Expenses of Liquor Commission Under General Fund of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 61, § 13, amended. The 1st sentence of section 13 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed, as follows:

'The net profits of the commission shall be general revenue of the state.' Sec. 2. R. S., c. 61, § 14, amended. The last sentence of section 14 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All net revenue derived from such tax shall be deposited to the credit of the general fund of the State.'
