STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Payments of Benefits by Fraternal Beneficiary Societies to Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 60, § 202, amended. The last sentence of section 202 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby repeled and the following sentence enacted in place thereof:

'Provided, however, that any such society having admitted assets as shown by its annual statement filed with the Commissioner in excess of 105% of its entire liabilities, including its required reserves, provided such reserves are at least equivalent to the amount required by the Commissioner's standard ordinary table of mortality with interest at 3% per annum, may pay the full amount of the policy at all ages without regard to the aforementioned limitations.'
