STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE.

AN ACT Relating to Compensation Benefits Under the Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 31, § 13, amended. The 1st sentence of section 13 of chapter 31 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following sentence enacted in place thereof:
- 'At the termination of total disability under the provisions of section 11, the employee shall receive, in addition thereto, compensation for the injuries included in the following schedule for the periods specified therein, during which additional specified periods the employee shall be deemed totally incapacitated for work.'
