## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Certain Deductions from Municipal Employees' Salaries by Town Treasurers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91, § 85-A, additional. Chapter 91 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 85-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 85-A. Deductions from employees' salaries. The treasurer of any municipality shall and is authorized to make deductions from employees' salaries to cover

- I. Insurance premiums;
- II. The purchase of United States Savings Bonds;
- III. The Purchase of shares in credit unions organized under the federal law or chartered by the State of Maine; and
- IV. Dues in professional organization of teachers.

Said deductions shall be made on the written authorization of each individual employee involved. The treasurer shall and is authorized to pay over to the proper payee the amounts so deducted.'
