SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 127, L.D. 336, Bill, "An Act to
Revise the Taxation Laws Relating to Towns."

Amend said Bill by striking out paragraph D of subsection IV
of section 10 of that part designated "Chapter 91-A" and inserting
in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'D. The polls of all persons who have attained the age of
70 years and the polls and estates of all persons who by
reason of infirmity or poverty are in the judgment of the
assessors unable to contribute toward the public charges.'
