**AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Justices of Supreme Judicial Court and
Superior Court.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 103, § 4, amended. The 1st sentence of section 4 of chapter 103 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court shall each receive an annual salary of ~~\$11,000~~ \$14,000, and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$12,000~~ \$15,000.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 106, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 106 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Each of the Justices of the Superior Court shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$10,500~~ \$12,500.'
