STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to an Expense Account for Governor-Elect.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. II, § 2-A, additional. Chapter II of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 2-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 2-A. Expense account of Governor-elect. There shall be established the "Governor-elect's expense account" to which shall be credited the sum of \$3,000 as a continuing reserve. At the close of each fiscal year there shall be transferred from unappropriated surplus an amount sufficient to restore such expense account to \$3,000.

This appropriation shall be available for expenditure by the Governor-elect at his discretion, provided he is Governor-elect to his first term in office. This account shall not be subject to audit, except as to total amount to be paid.'
