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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Northern Maine Sanatorium.**

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**Northern Maine Sanatorium; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$15,000 for the Northern Maine Sanatorium for the purpose of renovating and making major repairs at the Children's Building at this Institution; and be it further

**Resolved:** That any balances at June 30, 1956 shall be carried forward to the 1956-1957 fiscal year, but all unencumbered appropriation balances shall lapse June 30, 1957.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

The entire front of the Knight Building, so-called Children's Building, is of porch-type construction and not adequately designed to prevent leaking in stormy weather. Constant deterioration has taken place to such an extent that now sills, girders and posts are in immediate need of repair or replacement.

In making the structural repairs it is proposed to install double-hung windows and make the front of this building weather-proof. This request is based upon an engineer's estimate.
