STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Group Life Insurance Standard Provisions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 60, § 165, sub-§ III, ¶ F, amended. Paragraph F of subsection III of section 165 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'F. A provision that any sum becoming due by reason of the death of the person insured shall be payable to the beneficiary designated by the person insured, subject to the provisions of the policy in the event there is no designated beneficiary as to all or any part of such sum living at the death of the person insured, and subject to any right reserved by the insurer in the policy and set forth in the certificate to pay at its option a part of such sum not exceeding \$250 \$500 to any person appearing to the insurer to be equitably entitled there by reason of having incurred funeral or other expenses incident to the last illness or death of the person insured.
