**AN ACT Relating to Reimbursement of Towns for Transportation or Board of
School Children.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 43, amended. The 1st sentence of section 43 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Where the distance from the place of temporary residence to the school is more than 2 miles and transportation is deemed advisable by the superintending school committee, the superintendent of schools shall report the same to the Commissioner with such other information as may be required and if so directed by the Commissioner shall procure transportation for such child or children or, if transportation is inadvisable, board in lieu thereof; provided that when there shall be reported to the Commissioner in connection with the annual report a bill of expenses incurred in connection with such transportation or board, the Commissioner is authorized to reimburse such towns and plantations for such expenses, the same to be paid **annually in December** from the ~~state school fund~~ **and at the time of the distribution of such fund department appropriation for the purpose.**'
