RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Coffee Pond in Cumberland County.

Fishing in Coffee Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Coffee Pond in Casco, in the county of Cumberland, to ice fishing for smelts, 2 jig lines only and no live bait, from February 1 on, limit 15 smelts daily. Legal to keep any pickerel, perch, chub or other rough fish caught while fishing for smelts.
