SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 156, L. D. 350, Bill, "An Act Repealing County Laws Relating to Meridian Lines and Standards of Length."

Amend said Bill by striking out the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title:

'An Act Relating to Meridian Lines and Standards of Length in Kennebec County.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., c. 89, Sec. 94-A, additional. Chapter 89 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 94-A, to read as follows:

Sec. 94-A. Exception. The provisions of sections 89 to 94, inclusive, shall not apply to the county of Kennebec.
