HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 159, L.D. 353, Bill, "An Act Revising
the Laws on Civil Defense and Public Safety."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of the 1st paragraph
of that part designated "Sec. 9" of section 3, the following
underlined sentence:

'It shall be unlawful for the operator of a motor vehicle or
other vehicle or conveyance of any kind to fail or refuse to
stop any such motor vehicle or other vehicle or conveyance of
any kind upon request or signal of a duly appointed civil defense
and public safety law enforcement officer in uniform of a local,
state and sheriffs organization in times of emergency or during
authorized alerts, including partial or full mobilization.'
