STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Payments by Northport Village Corporation to Town of Northport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1915, c. 136, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 136 of the private and special laws of 1915 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 5. Certain amount to be paid over annually. The town of Northport shall, from time to time as taxes are collected, pay over to the treasurer of said corporation, out of the taxes collected from the inhabitants and estates within the territory of the Northport Village Corporation aforesaid, a sum equal to sixty percentum of all the town taxes, exclusive of the state and county tax, collected from said inhabitants and estates until the 31st day of March, 1956; and thereafter the assessors of the town of Northport shall add the sum of \$5,000 to the assessment which would otherwise be committed each year to the constable or collector for collection; and the town of Northport shall, from time to time as taxes are collected, pay over the said sum to the treasurer of the said corporation.'
