STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Licensed Practical Nurses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 70, § 1, sub-§ V, amended. The 1st sentence of subsection V of section I of chapter 70 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Any person who holds a license to practice as a licensed nursing attendant in this State shall have the right to use the title "Licensed Nursing Attendant" "Licensed Practical Nurse" and abbreviation "L. N. A." "L. P. N.".'

Sec. 2. Amendatory clause. Wherever in the Revised Statutes or public laws, the words "nursing attendant" or "nursing attendants" appear they shall be repealed and the words "practical nurse" or "practical nurses" enacted in place thereof.
