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**AN ACT Relating to Specially Designed Motor Vehicle Number Plates for  
Maine Members in Congress.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 18, amended.** The first sentence of the last paragraph of section 18 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘The Secretary of State shall, upon application therefor by **Maine members of the United States Senate, Maine members of the United States House of Representatives**, members of the Executive Council, members of the Legislature, President of the Senate, Speaker of the House, Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House, issue 1 pair of specially designed number plates and a certificate of registration for 1 designated motor vehicle owned or controlled by each of the officials named herein.’
