RESOLVE, in Favor of H. Tabenken & Co., Inc., of Bangor.

H. Tabenken & Co., Inc.; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$175 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the State Liquor Commission to be paid to the H. Tabenken & Co., Inc., of Bangor, to reimburse them for a special permit for the temporary storage of malt liquors. The privilege granted under this special permit was not exercised by the licensee.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A temporary malt liquor permit was issued to H. Tabenken & Company, Inc., April 15, 1953, for a period of 7 months for premises located on Washburn Avenue, Caribou. The special privileges granted by this permit were not exercised, therefore the company is asking for a refund.
