STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of a Science and Classroom Building at Gorham State Teachers College.

Science and classroom building; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$434,000 in favor of Gorham State Teachers College to construct a Science and classroom building; and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been completed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Gorham State Teachers College is overcrowded and the construction of a new Science and classroom building will alleviate this condition and also make better provision for Science education. As now tentatively planned the Science and classroom building may be a wing of a new library building which is also much needed for the development of the college. The Science and classroom building will contain classrooms and laboratories for the teaching of Biology, Physics, Physical Science, Chemistry and Geology.
