AN ACT Relating to Transportation of Explosives.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 97, § 43-A, additional. Chapter 97 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 43-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 43-A. Transportation of explosives. As a condition to the granting of a permit or license to transport explosives, the Insurance Commissioner may require that the vehicle used in transportation of explosives may be accompanied by a representative of the Commissioner, who shall be paid mileage by the person to whom the license is issued at the rate allowed to fire inspectors by the State for the use of his car. This condition is not applicable to loads of 4,000 pounds or less.'
