RESOLVE, to Reimburse Cecil Merrill of Dixfield for Damage Done by State Ward.

Cecil Merrill; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$5,000 to be paid to Cecil Merrill of Dixfield, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damages done to his house by Robert Batchelder a state ward.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Robert Batcheler, a state ward, lived with Reba Hatfield of Dixfield, and burned down the house owned by Cecil Merrill of Dixfield. He confessed and was taken to the Rumford Municipal Court.
