STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Exits from and Means of Extinguishing Fire in School Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 27, amended. The 4th sentence of section 27 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'In all school buildings of more than \pm story there shall be at least 2 separate means of egress by inside or outside stairways, and each story above the first shall be supplied with means of extinguishing fire, consisting of pails of water or other portable apparatus sprinkler systems, fire extinguishers, or of a hose attached to a suitable water supply, and such appliances shall be kept at all times ready for use and in good condition.'
