AN ACT to Supplement Loans by Maine School Building Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 248, sub-§ XIII-A, additional. Section 248 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered XIII-A, to read as follows:

'XIII-A. As funds may be made available for the purpose, to supplement, on a grant basis, lease agreements with those towns where the maximum loan agreement that the Authority will approve is not sufficient to finance the minimum classroom facilities needed. Determination as to eligibility shall be under such rules and regulations as the Authority shall make and its determination shall be final upon approval of the Governor and Council.'
