AN ACT Relating to Requirements in Construction of School Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 51, sub-§ I, amended. Subsection I of section 51 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

I. Flush closets. Flush water closets connected with sewer, filter bed or septic tanks ~~or protected cesspool~~, with separate compartments for the sexes, accessible only by separate passageways from schoolsrooms or corridors.'
