AN ACT Relating to Permits to Haul Farm Products Over Certain Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 22, § 100, amended. Section 100 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the 1st sentence thereof, a new sentence, to read as follows :

'The State Highway Commission shall grant permits upon proper application in writing for hauling farm, dairy, horticultural and perishable products from farm to market over the highways specified in the preceding sentence during such periods of each year.'
