RESOLVE, Reappropriating Road Resolve Funds in town of Kennebunkport.

Town of Kennebunkport; money reallocated. Resolved: That the balance of \$1,600 accumulated from special road resolves allocated by previous legislatures to aid in the repair of state aid road No. 2, beginning at Dock Square and following the Kennebunk river, thence easterly and northeasterly to Cape Porpoise and ending at state aid No. 1 near the residence of the late J. Frank Seavey, be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended to aid in repairing road designated on State Highway Commission records as special resolve No. 1, beginning near the residence of the late Frank Meserve and running northeasterly to Hutchins' school, thence easterly on Ice Pond road to state route No. 9 (S. A. #1).

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Kennebunkport has an accumulated \$1,600 balance on the special road resolves and this is needed to repair state aid road No. 2.
