RESOLVE, Reappropriating Road Resolve Funds in the Town of Mars Hill.

Town of Mars Hill; money reallocated. Resolved: That the sum of \$874.84 accumulated from special road resolves appropriated by previous legislatures to aid in repairing a road leading from the nearest state highway to the base of Mars Hill, and constructing adequate foot trails to the summit of said hill, be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended for construction of a road leading from the town way known as the Mountain Road to the base of Mars Hill, providing the citizens at the annual town meeting accept said proposed road, or money shall be used on a portion of the original East Ridge Road, which is known locally as the Clarence York Road.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Money was appropriated in 1939 and 1941 for repairs on above roads. Has not been previously expended and roads need attention.
