STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Retirement Pensions for Police and Fire Departments of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1927, c. 75, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 75 of the private and special laws of 1927, as enacted by chapter 28 of the private and special laws of 1929 and repealed and replaced by chapter 37 of the private and special laws of 1949, is hereby amended by adding after the 1st sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'The city of Portland is further authorized to pay to such members of the police and fire departments a sum, not to exceed 50c per day, in addition to the amount of pension per day above specified.'
