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**AN ACT to Provide Refunds on Certain Liquor License Fees.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 61, § 32, amended.** Section 32 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

‘When a license issued under the provisions of this section is surrendered by a licensee during the license period, other than for violation of the liquor laws or rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, the Commission shall make an order on the Treasurer of State to remit to such licensee the license fee after deducting  $\frac{1}{12}$  of the full fee for every month, any part of which the license has been in effect. All months in the year up to and including the month in which surrender is requested shall be considered as months during which the license has been in effect and no refunds shall be made after October 31 in any year.’
