RESOLVE, Authorizing the Commissioner of Institutional Service to Convey to Portland Water District a Right of Way for a Pipeline over Land of the Reformatory for Men in South Windham.

Commissioner of institutional service, in name of State of Maine, authorized to convey a certain right-of-way. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Institutional Service, in the name of the State of Maine, be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to convey by quit claim deed to Portland Water District, its successors and assigns, the right perpetually to enter at any and all times upon a strip of land owned by the State of Maine and situated in the town of Windham, in the county of Cumberland and state of Maine, said strip being shown on a plan entitled "Plan Showing Proposed Portland Water District Right of Way across Land of Maine State Reformatory for Men, South Windham, Maine," dated January 19, 1955, said plan being now on file in the office of the Secretary of State, to which plan reference is hereby made for a more particular description of said strip, and to construct and perpetually maintain through and across said strip conduits or pipe lines for conveying water and to lay, relay, repair, maintain and remove water pipe or pipes upon or under said strip with all necessary fixtures and appurtenances.
