STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Regulating the Taking of Alewives in St. George River in the Town of Warren.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1949, c. 109, amended. The 2nd paragraph of chapter 109 of the private and special laws of 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘The town at its annual town meeting may determine by vote whether the alewife fishing in these waters shall be operated by the town, through its selectmen or a committee appointed for that purpose, or the privilege offered for sale by said selectmen or committee; and likewise may provide for regulations, compatible with the general laws of the State, to govern the times when and the manner in which alewives shall be taken therein. Provided, however, that there shall be a 24-hour weekly closed season on alewives in all such waters from sunrise on each ~~Sunday~~ ~~Saturday~~ morning until sunrise on the following ~~Monday~~ ~~Sunday~~ morning.’
