COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 402, L. D. 418, Bill, "An Act Prohibiting Commercial Digging of Clams in Brooklin and Sedgwick, Hancock County."

Amend said Bill by striking out the comma at the end of the 8th line from the end and inserting in place thereof a period.

Further amend said Bill by striking out the 7th line from the end and inserting in place thereof the following: ' Nothing herein shall prohibit a resident or riparian owner of shores or flats in their respective towns from digging and taking one-half bushel of clams therefrom for food for himself and family.'
