AN ACT Relating to the Printing of the Blood Type of the Operator on the Operator's License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. The 7th sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 60 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Each license shall state the name, age, place of residence of the licensee and the distinguishing numbers or marks assigned to him and may contain a brief description of the licensee for the purpose of identification and such other information as the said Secretary shall deem necessary, **together with the voluntary listing of the licensee's blood type. Blood type shall be obtained from any recognized institution having proper laboratory facilities.**'
