AN ACT Relating to Complimentary Fishing and Hunting Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 39, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 39 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'The Commissioner may issue complimentary fishing and hunting licenses to officials of the Conservation Departments of other States and of the Canadian Provinces, not exceeding 30 in any one year.'
