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## STATE OF MAINE

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### **AN ACT to Prevent the Pollution of the Waters of Sebago Lake.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1903, c. 94, § 2, amended.** The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 94 of the private and special laws of 1903, as amended by section 2 of chapter 188 of the private and special laws of 1907, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

‘No sewage, drainage, refuse or polluting matter of any kind shall be dumped or discharged into said Sebago lake or any of its direct tributaries from steamboats, **motor boats, yachts** or other craft of any description, ~~carrying passengers for hire plying on said Sebago lake or any of its direct tributaries~~ or from any other source; but every such steamboat, **motor boat, yacht** and other craft shall be equipped with water tight receptacles which shall be dumped only on land and at such a distance from the shores of said lake and its direct tributaries and in such a manner that no part thereof, or any drainage therefrom, shall enter said lake or any of its direct tributaries.’
