STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Prevent the Pollution of the Waters of Sebago Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1903, c. 94, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 94 of the private and special laws of 1903, as amended by section 2 of chapter 188 of the private and special laws of 1907, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'No sewage, drainage, refuse or polluting matter of any kind shall be dumped or discharged into said Sebago lake or any of its direct tributaries from steamboats, motor boats, yachts or other craft of any description, carrying passengers for hire plying on said Sebago lake or any of its direct tributaries or from any other source; but every such steamboat, motor boat, yacht and other craft shall be equipped with water tight receptacles which shall be dumped only on land and at such a distance from the shores of said lake and its direct tributaries and in such a manner that no part thereof, or any drainage therefrom, shall enter said lake or any of its direct tributaries.'
