AN ACT Increasing Salary of the Recorder of the Augusta Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1919, c. 75, § 12, amended. The last sentence of section 12 of chapter 75 of the private and special laws of 1919, as last amended by chapter 87 of the private and special laws of 1949, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Said recorder shall be appointed for a term of 4 years, and until his successor has duly qualified, and as compensation in full for his services shall receive ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,500 per year, payable by the county of Kennebec in the same manner as the salary of said judge.
