STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Pauper Relief.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 94, § 20, amended. The 1st sentence of section 20 of chapter 94 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The father, mother, grandfather, grandmother, children and grandchildren, by consanguinity, living within the State, or owning property within the State, and of sufficient ability, shall support persons chargeable in proportion to their respective ability.'
