AN ACT Relating to Powers of State Fire Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 97, § 29, amended. Section 29 of chapter 97 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the 3rd sentence thereof, the following sentences:

'State supervising fire inspectors shall have the same powers and duties throughout the several counties of the State as sheriffs have in their respective counties relating to fire prevention and crimes against habitations, arson and other burnings. Their power and duties shall include the duty to inquire into and arrest for violations of any of the provisions of this chapter, and to arrest for impersonation of or interference with fire inspectors.'
