COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 411, L.D. 458, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Right of Officer to Kill Dogs."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last 2 lines thereof
and inserting in place thereof the following:

"wounding or killing any domestic animal, when said dog is out-
side of the enclosure or immediate care of its owner or keeper.
For the purpose of this section "enclosure" shall mean the ken-
nel, kennel run, or fenced-in area in which the dog is ordinarily
confined. "Immediate care" shall mean that the dog shall be close
enough to the owner or keeper that he can exercise control over
the dog."
