STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Gill Nets.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 52, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 52 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed as follows:

'Gill nets of not larger than 11/4 inch mesh may be used in the taking of white fish in Eastern Grand lake and Hot Brook lake in Aroostook and Washington counties, and in Baskahegan lake, Pocumpus lake and Western Grand lake, all in Washington county, and Junior lake, in Penobscot county, and in Mattawamkeag lake in Aroostook county, and in First Debsconcag lake and Thoroughfare leading to the West Branch of the Penobscot river, in the county of Piscataquis during the month of November of each year.'
