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### **AN ACT Relating to Filling Vacancies in Membership of Council in Fort Kent.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1945, c. 34, § 2, amended.** The 2nd paragraph of section 2 of chapter 34 of the private and special laws of 1945 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'At the 1st meeting held under the provisions of this act, 5 councillors shall be chosen, as follows: 2 for the term of 1 year, 2 for the term of 2 years and 1 for the term of 3 years, who shall constitute the council; and thereafter at each of said annual meetings 2 councillors shall be chosen as herein provided, each for a term of 3 years, provided, however, that in each 3rd year but 1 councillor shall be chosen; and provided further, that vacancies in the office of councillor, due to death, resignation or other cause, shall be filled at the next ~~annual~~ **special or regular town** meeting for the unexpired term.'
