## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Providing for the Appointment of a Civil Engineer of the City of Lewiston by the Department of Public Works.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. VIII, § 12, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 12 of article VIII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, which was enacted by section 2 of chapter 209 of the private and special laws of 1949, which deals with the appointment of a civil engineer by the board of finance, is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. X, § 4, amended. Section 4 of article X of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as repealed and replaced by section 6 of chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1943, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 4. Employees; civil engineer. The board shall have full power and authority to employ such superintendents, engineers, inspectors, foremen, agents and employees as may be required for the administration of the affairs of the department, prescribe their duties, set their compensation subject to the approval of the board of finance and terminate their employment at pleasure.

The board of public works shall appoint a full-time civil engineer who shall be subject to the authority of said board. The board shall prescribe his duties and assign him to any department of the city for such time or times and under such rules and regulations as they may order, fix his compensation subject to the approval of the board of finance and terminate his employment at pleasure.'
