RESOLVE, in Favor of Wyman and Simpson, Inc., of Augusta.

Wyman & Simpson, Inc.; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$111,160.32 to reimburse Wyman & Simpson, Inc., of Augusta, for loss sustained in connection with the construction of Martin Point Bridge.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The contract price for the construction of Martin Point Bridge was named when normal conditions were existing. War conditions brought about definite increases in labor rates and cost of materials, which could not be taken into consideration when the contract price was estimated. Therefore, an actual loss on this construction work amounted to \$111,160.32.
