STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Forest Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 36, § 1, amended. The last sentence of section 1 of chapter 36 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The Commissioner shall receive an annual salary of \$9,000 \$10,500, of which amount \$6,000 \$7,000 shall be paid from funds raised and created by the tax assessed under the provisions of section 96.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 36, § 109, amended. The last sentence of section 109 of chapter 36 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The Commissioner shall also receive from said funds the sum of \$6,000 \$7,000 per year in addition to the salary as now provided by law.'
