**AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Anticipated Overdrafts in the Harness
Racing Commission Due to Insufficient Appropriations.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the funds appropriated for the present functions of the Harness Racing Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955 are insufficient; and

Whereas, existing statutes provide for these functions as a direct obligation of the state; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Emergency appropriation. In order to provide for the necessary expenditures of government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955, the following sum or as much thereof as shall be found necessary, as designated in the following tabulation, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated:

Harness Racing Commission	\$1,500

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
