## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Reimbursement to Municipalities for Extraordinary Hospital Expenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 94, § 24-A, additional. Chapter 94 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 24-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 24-A. Municipality reimbursed for certain hospital expenses. The State shall reimburse the municipality of settlement for its expenditures in excess of two tenths of one per cent of its valuation, as determined by the Board of Equalization, for care of dependent persons in a general hospital, provided such care has been furnished and paid during the same fiscal year of said municipality. Expenditures for maintenance and support of a municipally operated hospital and care in the municipally operated hospital of dependent persons having settlement in the municipality operating such hospital, or for support of a hospital under the provisions of section 102 of chapter 91 shall not be considered in determining any liability of the State for reimbursement.'
